



Hale Family Sunflower Promise Scholarship Criteria

- A minimum of \$5,000 shall be distributed in the form of new and renewals scholarships.
- Scholarship funds can be used to cover tuition, books and required campus/course fees. Residence and meal costs are excluded.
- Applicants must be Kansas community college students who have completed 2 years of coursework and wish to further their higher education at a four-year secondary institution in Kansas.
- Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 to qualify for the scholarship, and maintain that minimum GPA in order to receive the second semester distribution.
- Applicants should have demonstrated leadership, commitment, and the potential for betterment of Kansas while studying at the community college. These qualities will be verified through a letter of reference from a faculty member or community leader.
- Applicants must submit an essay outlining what they want to accomplish with their education and how they hope to make Kansas a better place through their accomplishments.
- Scholarship recipients who maintain a grade point average of 3.2 or better may be considered for a scholarship renewal the following year.
