



## **James L. Ogden Memorial Scholarship Criteria**

- \$1,000 shall be distributed in the form of an annual scholarship. The scholarship will be awarded by semester (\$500 each in the fall and spring semesters.)
- Applicants must be currently attending Kansas State University or the University of Kansas with a declared major in Civil Engineering and a minimum of twelve (12) hours completed in his/her major.
- Student must submit an official copy of his/her transcript with the application.
- Student must submit a written essay as outlined on the application.
- Students must have a current GPA of 2.5 or above.

James L. Ogden was an engineering technician and land surveyor in the civil engineering field for the Kansas Department of Transportation.

He believed in working hard to accomplish his goals. He valued learning, and encouraged his children to pursue education beyond high school.

Mr. Ogden's other career was serving his country. For more than 20 years he served in the Army National Guard and Reserves.

Mr. Ogden was killed in a work-related accident near Lindsborg, Kansas on October 31, 1997. This scholarship was established in his memory.
